Higlights of Croatia with Superior Cruise

Day 1 • ZAGREB

You will be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel. The balance of the day is at leisure. Dinner is on us tonight.

Meals: Dinner

Day 2 • ZAGREB

We enjoy a morning sightseeing tour through the historic Upper Town. We see St. Mark's Church, St. Catherine's Church, the Cathedral, the Parliament, and the Government Palace. The rest of the day is at leisure

to explore the winding streets of the old town or perhaps take an optional excursion into the countryside. Meals: Breakfast

Day 3 • ZAGREB - PLITVICE LAKES - SPLIT

We head south for a visit to the magnificent Plitvice Lakes National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Here, we enjoy the breathtaking scenery of this natural wonder with its 16 terraced lakes surrounded by forested mountains and lush vegetation. A walking tour takes us around several of the lower lakes. After our visit, we continue our drive to Split harbor,

where embarkation begins at 14:00h. Get settled in your cabin before going on a walking tour of Split around 18:00h and visit the seafront promenade and Roman Emperor Diocletian's Palace. The historical center of the city is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. After returning to ship enjoy a Welcome reception followed by dinner this evening.

Meals: Breakfast, Welcome reception and dinner

Day 4 • SPLIT - VIS

In the morning set sail to Vis. Cruise towards the island of Vis once a strategic naval Yugoslav base and restricted to the public. Due to this isolation, Vis has a special charm – "the Mediterranean as it once was" making it interesting

to visit. Since the independence of Croatia, the island began opening slowly to the outside world. Some of Europe's largest and greatest naval battles had happened in the waters of Vis. Vis Island holds many historic secrets and we will explore Vis history by military Land Rover Defenders. Overnight in one of the harbors on the island of Vis.

Meals: Breakfast and lunch

Day 5 • VIS ISLAND -BIŠEVO - HVAR ISLAND

Leaving Vis in the morning sail towards Biševo island to visit the Blue Cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon on the islet Biševo just in front of Komiža. The possibility of our visit will depend on weather conditions; however, you will be notified of this on time. Afterward, continue to the island of Hvar, take a swim break, and continue sailing through lunch,

arriving at the island of Hvar this afternoon. Join a guided tour of the town of Hvar where you will see many historical sights of the town, such as St Stephen's Square and Cathedral, the Arsenal with the theatre built on its first floor, the first municipal theatre in Europe. Above Hvar Town is the impressive fortress Fortica offering magnificent views over the bay and

Pakleni islands. Overnight in Hvar or Stari Grad.

Meals: Breakfast and lunch

Day 6 • HVAR ISLAND - LASTOVO NATURE PARK

Take a break for a swim during your morning cruise. Continue sailing through lunch, arriving this afternoon in Lastovo, an island known for its Venetian architecture from the 15th and 16th centuries. The island of Lastovo and the Lastovo archipelago, which includes 46 islands, islets, rocks, and reefs, is a nature park in Croatia where the sea is crystal clear and the sky is full of stars that shine like the most beautiful evening gown. We dock in the port of Ubli where you can enjoy your free time and explore the beauty of the island. From there, a local taxi can take you to the town of Lastovo, where you can visit a local winery and taste some of the indigenous varieties of wine on your own. Overnight in Lastovo.

Meals on board: Breakfast and lunch

Day 7 • LASTOVO - KORČULA

Early in the morning, we set sail for the island of Korčula, with a swimming stop, if weather permits, in one of the pristine bays, time to relax and lunch on board. Continue towards Korčula, the most preserved medieval town, thought to be the birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo. We will spend the night here. Take a walking tour of Korčula which takes you through its narrow, cobbled streets full of history. The evening is free to explore the town on your own

Meals on board: Breakfast and lunch

Day 8 • KORČULA - MLJET NATIONAL PARK - SLANO

In the morning head further south to the Island of Mljet. Join the Cruise Manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park. Alternatively, you can rent bicycles, scooters, or kayaks to explore the National Park or island on your own. Lunch on board and departure for a small village called Slano on the mainland. Slano is a peaceful fishermen's

village, and the starting point to Ston, situated on the Pelješac peninsula, a fortified small village famous for its oysters. Pelješac peninsula is known as one of the best wine-producing regions in Croatia. After exploring the town, we leave for a small nearby village to enjoy the authentic local oyster tasting. Tonight, enjoy Captain's dinner and overnight in Slano.

Meals on board: Breakfast. lunch, tasting, and Captain's dinner

DAY 9 • SLANO - DUBROVNIK

Early morning cruise to Elaphiti islands with a swim stop on one of the secluded bays. Continue sail to Dubrovnik, and, before we moor at port, we cruise alongside the old city walls. After docking, join a guided tour at the historical center of Dubrovnik, and walk through Stradun – both a street and a square, the most famous place inside the town walls, enlisted as UNESCO's World Heritage site. Your guide will show you the most interesting sights of the Old Town and visit the Franciscan Monastery with its Pharmacy. After city tour, you will be on your own to explore the city, visit City Walls, the Franciscan Monastery with Europe's second oldest pharmacy, the Rector's Palace, and the Cathedral, or take a boat ride to Lokrum island or take the cable car to the top of the Mount Srđ. Overnight in Dubrovnik. Meals on board: Breakfast and lunch

Day 10 • DUBROVNIK

After breakfast it's time to disembark no later than 9:00h. You will be transferred to Dubrovnik airport.
